Granblue Fantasy: how to install, play and transfer accounts in English.

Granblue Fantasy is easily one of, if not the biggest mobile game in the world, boasting well over 18 million players to date. So when the developers finally decided to create an English version for international audiences last year, people were understandably enthusiastic. After all, this is a game known for its collaborations. Just in the last 18 months, we have had the pleasure of reuniting with characters from Street Fighter, Sakura Wars, Attack On Titan, Cardcaptor Sakura, and many more.

Sadly, Cygames still has no plans to actually release the game on western mobile storefronts (Google Play Store, iTunes, etc.). That means people who don't understand Japanese have to rely on some assistance in order to navigate through the different untranslated menus just to experience it properly. Fortunately, we hope to assuage your fears through this handy guide!

How to play Granblue Fantasy's English Release.

So, you want to play Granblue Fantasy. Unfortunately, it's not as popular or as easily found in the West as in Japan, but players outside of Asia do have a few options - and it's worthwhile, considering the game has a near-perfect English translation. First off, you've got to decide if you're playing on PC or on mobile - and depending on which you plump for, the method of getting the Granblue Fantasy you use will differ slightly.

How to Play Granblue Fantasy on PC via Google Chrome or Apple Safari.

Before we begin, I should note you can only play Granblue Fantasy via Google Chrome or an Apple Safari browser . I also recommend going through this process first to set up your account to begin as it's a whole lot easier than dealing with it through the mobile app. First things first, head over to http://granbluefantasy.jp/en/. Along the left side of the page, you'll see a bar that says "Links". Go ahead and click on that to pull out a drawer giving you links to the Chrome registration page.

Click the "Play Now!" banner at the top of this drawer to proceed. This will open up the game itself. From there, under "Set Language", go ahead and change it to English (if you prefer), clicking the "Save Changes" button below the drop-down box. Click "New Game" once that is done with.

This will guide you through the game's tutorial. Feel free to skip it if you'd like by clicking the Skip button at the bottom of the dialog box and clicking OK. However, I highly recommend newcomers having a go through it anyway. Not only will it teach you the ropes of Granblue Fantasy, but you'll also experience how amazing the production values are! I won't go into the Tutorial here as it's pretty self-explanatory. Of course, if you have any trouble, make sure to leave a comment and we will do our best to help!

Once you have gone through the tutorial, you'll come to the Link page. Click on the Mobage button on the far left. This will open up a new tab where you can create your Mobage account. Be sure to use Chrome's built-in translation function to make your life a lot easier if you can't read Japanese.

Now, enter your email address in the box at the bottom of the page and click the green button next to it to move on. You'll be presented with a box with a space to enter a code. Leave this tab open as you'll be sent a confirmation email, so go ahead and check your inbox. It may have gone

to your spam box (don't take it out since Mobage loves sending email), so check it for a message from "[email protected]". Inside that email is a certification number. Copy it and enter it into the box from before.

Now you'll be able to set up your account properly. Be sure to rely on that Google Translate feature, as I mentioned. If you don't have access to that function, it just goes:

Username Password Confirm Password Gender (Male or Female) Birth Year / Month / Day Check box if you want to keep your birthday hidden Password Secret Question Secret Answer Check box to accept terms and conditions (should already be checked)

After you have submitted the form by clicking the green button at the bottom, you'll be presented with yet another box. Only this time, you're done! Click the green button to enter the game. You'll be logged in using the username and password you chose during the registration process. Make sure to write this information down just in case.

After clicking that green button, you'll be taken to a page that mentions something like "Service Link Issues". This is completely normal as it happens every time you make a new account, so don't be caught off guard if you see it. Just click the brown Cancel button at the bottom to proceed. You'll head back to the main menu where you originally began, so you can go ahead and click the Start button to continue on with the tutorial. You'll go back to the Link page where you want to click Mobage yet again. This will link up your accounts (bypassing the service link issue we had before) and send you to the homepage. You can either decide to go ahead with the browser version or use the mobile release instead - they both use the same login information.

Downloading Granblue Fantasy on Mobile: QooApp & APK Download on Android or the Japanese iOS Store.

This acts the same way as the PC version does. After all, Granblue Fantasy is a browser game, so that only makes sense, right? In fact, you could just play the game entirely through your Google Chrome mobile browser with the Data Saver feature on. It's the most optimized way to play it and you won't hurt your bandwidth in the end compared to using the native Granblue Fantasy app. If you'd rather use the app directly, however, that's possible too - but you're going to have to follow a few additional steps, which we'll detail below.

On an Apple device, this can be a little tricky. You'll need to create a Japanese iTunes account. I recommend hitting up this very useful guide on how to create a Japanese iTunes account, and then find yourself the iOS version of Granblue Fantasy on the store. Download it, and the same broad account guidelines that we've outlined here will apply on iOS devices.

If you have an Android phone, you've two options. One is to find and install an Android APK for Granblue Fantasy - that is, the raw installation file for the game, side-loaded onto your phone without the official app store. That's less safe and more difficult than the alternative, however - and here, we're going to detail the alternative step-by-step.

For the first step, you'll need to go ahead and download a handy piece of software called QooApp by visiting this link and clicking on the blue button below the logo. Since it's an unsigned app that isn't technically approved through Google, you won't be able to get it through the Play Store, but if you install a genuine version of it you'll be quite safe - just be sure to double and triple check what you're downloading and installing. And only download it from the official site.

QooApp is a handy little app indeed since it allows you to download a lot of different Japanese games despite living in a different region. Once QooApp is installed go ahead and open it, and you'll want to - you guessed it - search for Granblue Fantasy. Download the app from here just like you would on the regular Google Play Store.

To do this, you may have to give the app some additional permissions including the installation of apps from unknown sources. As we said earlier, don't worry too much about the legitimacy as a lot of people use QooApp (including yours truly) without any worries - just be sure to keep an eye on what you're installing and double, triple check if you're unsure of an app's origin. For grabbing a popular game like Granblue Fantasy this is perfect, however.

After you have installed Granblue Fantasy, you have a decision to make. If you have already created an account using the PC version and have your Chrome profile synced to your phone, go ahead and launch the app, Whether you're on Android or iOS, you'll be presented with the same screen as shown above. Whatever you do, DON'T click the blue button! That's only to be used if you are just starting.

Instead, click the gray box right below it. This will open up a web browser. you'll see a page that says something the lines of, "You are trying to login to "Granblue Fantasy" with (blank)'s account. Do you allow it?" with an orange bar below it. Go ahead and click that button to proceed to link your account.

If you haven't already registered an account, don't launch the app because registering an account through the app is a confusing mess, and you don't need that kind of stress. Instead, go to http://sp.mbga.jp on your phone's browser. On the top right corner, you'll see a button that says "Log In". Go ahead and click that, and you'll be presented with a screen.

At the very bottom, click on the gray button to register an account. On the next page, enter a valid email address in the top text bar and click the orange button below it to confirm. You'll be sent a confirmation email containing a code you'll want to put in the box. From there, you'll be taken to the account registration page with the same layout as before:

Username Password Confirm Password Gender (Male or Female) Birth Year / Month / Day Check box if you want to keep your birthday hidden Password Secret Question Secret Answer Check box to accept terms and conditions (should already be checked)

Hit that orange button at the bottom to proceed. You'll end up on a new page with an orange and green button, so go ahead and hit the orange button once more. Congratulations - you have set up a new account! Now, go ahead and launch the app and follow the instructions from the "you have a decision to make" paragraph. From there, you should be all good to go! Everything will be automatically synced so you can take your progress wherever you may roam.

As a note, you won't be able to easily log off from your account in Granblue Fantasy. You'll have to uninstall the game completely to start all over if you decide to change your information or reroll. Don't want to? Be sure to check out our next topic!

Transferring/Linking an Account in Granblue Fantasy.

Say you decided to buy yourself a new phone or you'd like to try out your party on a browser instead. This is where things can be a little complicated, but just follow along and I'll show you how it's done! I had to recently deal with this myself, so you won't have to struggle like I did on something that should be simple.

First, we'll share how you can link your account to your social media accounts so you don't even have to bother with remembering the email address you signed up with or your username and password. After you launch the app and before you click the Home button, scroll down to the very bottom and click "mobage" on the bottom left. When the new window opens up, click the picture of a person on the middle tab at the bottom of the page. Now, at the top near your adorable avatar, click the down arrow on the far right, followed by the Gear icon.

On the new page, about four buttons down, you should see something that says "SNS". Click that and press the orange button to open up a new browser. Click the blue button again, and you'll be presented with four options to link your account to: Facebook, Google+, Twitter, and Yahoo. Choose whichever account you want to sync up with, and the site will have you log into it.

And there you go! If you ever get a new phone or tablet and want to access your account, go ahead and visit that http://sp.mbga.jp page we shared before and log in using your social media account. This will make your life a heck of a lot easier, so I highly recommend linking your Granblue Fantasy account to your social media accounts immediately so you can avoid the headaches.

Rerolling.

Abusing the account creation process for rerolling is frowned upon by Cygames. Don't overdo it.

Contents.

Before Starting.

Gmail accounts are highly recommended for rerolling because they can use salts, which basically allows you to use the same e-mail multiple times for registration.

To use a salted e-mail, you add a +string between the name and the @gmail portion of your e-mail address. For example, if your Gmail account name was name@gmail.com, a salted e-mail would be name +1 @gmail.com, or name +text @gmail.com, and so forth. The string behind the + symbol can be any letters or numbers of any length, but, to easily keep track of rerolled accounts, we recommend using numbers. Any e-mails sent to a salted e-mail will be redirected to the email without the salt used, so in the previous example, any mail sent to any version of the email address would all be sent to name@gmail.com.

NOTE: Mobage sends a lot of e-mail spam, so you may want to avoid using a primary e-mail address for your Granblue Fantasy account. You can unsubscribe from emails, but it requires logging into Mobage from a mobile device (or forcing your browser to emulate a mobile device via Developer's Tools). See this for details.

Setting Up Chrome.

This tutorial assumes you are using Google Chrome (or another Chromium-based browser) for rerolling, as it is the easiest method to use.

Open a Google Chrome window in Incognito mode using Ctrl+Shift+N. This saves a lot of time clearing cookies between rerolls.

Creating An Account.

The date you create your account is important for the Beginner's Draw Set offer. The characters available on the draw set is based the characters available on the banner at the time the account was created. For example, an account created during Premium Gala can buy any Grand or Zodiac character with this offer.

Visit http://game.granbluefantasy.jp/ to be taken to the title screen. Under Game Settings, click on the dropdown menu and select English. Click the New Game button. The opening cutscenes and tutorial begins immediately after entering your name. See the Skipping The Tutorial section for information on how to quickly skip this. After the tutorial, a screen will ask you to choose a service to link with your Granblue Fantasy account. Click mobage. The takes you to the login/registration screen which is in Japanese. The text box labeled メールアドレスで会員登録 is where you want to input your salted gmail address. Then click the green button or hit Enter. Check your registered e-mail and enter the 4-digit verification code in the following screen. The next screen is in Japanese which you can use Google Translate to navigate. It asks for the following information (from top to bottom) Mobage display name (this will not be your in-game display name) Password Re-type password Gender (Can't be changed

after registration) Birth date (year, month, day) Checkbox 1: Publicly display your birth date (optional) Checkbox 2: Receive advertisements from mobage (optional) Enter in your information, then click the green button. If successful, you'll be taken to another screen with a green button which will let you obtain your first Beginner's Daily Bonus item, Premium Draw Ticket.

Birth date is important.

Due to Japanese law, accounts with birth dates under the age of 20 have a monthly in-app purchase limit of 10,000 JPY Japanese yen . If you plan on spending more than 10,000 JPY per month, make sure you enter a birth date of at least 20 years. You cannot change your birth date once you submit it.

A warning about "guest" accounts.

If you start an account through the mobile app (Android or iOS), you have an option to play as a "guest" account (officially called a "Mobage basic account") which lets you skip the registration process and instead associate your account to your device. If you do not connect a mobage account or social media account (Facebook, Google, Twitter, etc.) to your Granblue account, you risk permanently losing your Granblue account if you factory reset, lose your device, or uninstall the game app. You also cannot log into your Granblue account through the browser or other devices until a mobage account or social media account is connected.

A warning about connecting an account to Yahoo! Japan or Apple ID.

Buying Granblue Coins with a Yahoo! Japan account requires a Japanese mobile phone number or address. There is no other option to buy ingame coins, so connecting an account to Yahoo! is not recommended.

Apple ID is an option to log into the game, but since Apple IDs have an associated region attached to it, buying Granblue Coins may be difficult unless the ID already has its region set to Japan.

Creating a registered Mobage account for Granblue generally has the least known issues and has multiple payment options available.

Skipping The Tutorial.

First, it is strongly advised to play through the tutorial at least once. This tutorial is useful because it visually guides you through which buttons to press to do things like attack, use skills, equip weapons, and auto-select your weapon pool with optimal stats. The whole tutorial does take a while, but you can skip it on later rerolls to save time on the following steps.

When the introduction video starts, you will notice the URL in your address bar ends in #tutorial/3 . Increment the number at the end of the URL bar by 1, so it ends in #tutorial/4 , and press Enter to advance to the next step in the tutorial. Repeat this process 1 by 1 until #tutorial/6; you need to let the scene load, then click Skip to the lower left. At #tutorial/9 , change the URL directly to #tutorial/12 . Press Skip on #tutorial/12 to go to #tutorial/14 . ( Do not try going to #tutorial/13.) From here, skip directly to #tutorial/32 . This will bring you to the Link screen. Do not try to link an account here. Press Cancel to return to the title screen, then click Start and the game will automatically load you at #tutorial/30 . (It is not possible to skip directly to #tutorial/30 through URL manipulation.) Click Skip in the lower left twice, then you will be (properly) taken to the Link screen. See step #5 in Creating An Account above.

Note that the tutorial draw is rigged to always give nine N-rarity items and Walder.

## Gathering Draws.

There are two Premium Draw Ticket's and two JDA Magazine serial code tickets to gather per account. Premium Draw Ticket's have better yield and are less time-consuming to acquire, while JDA Magazine codes require entering serial codes and they draw from a fixed pool of prizes that are not affected by draw rate boosts.

All new accounts receive one free Premium 10-Part Draw a day for a week. Click the Draw button on your home page and scroll down until you see the free 10-pull button. This first Draw is rigged to always give you 1 SSR and 9 R/SR. The SSR will be one of the following characters: Zeta, Carmelina, Melleau, Charlotta, De La Fille or Lady Grey. Free Draws on subsequent days are regular Premium 10-Part Draws. When you reach the Home screen for the first time, you will be first taken through the Login Rewards. The first login reward is a Premium Draw Ticket. From the Home Page, click the arrow on the right side of the screen to visit the Town area. Click each gold sparkle on the map to receive some items. After all 4 sparkles turn silver, refresh the page, then visit the sparkles again in this order: top, left, right, middle. This gets you an extra Premium Draw Ticket. Completing the "Upgrade a Character" Pinboard Mission rewards a Max Level Ticket. Just feed a weapon to a character to complete the mission. On the Home Page, press the Top/News button in the top left to be taken to the title screen. Scroll down on this page until you see a button labeled Serial Codes . Click that banner and enter the following two serial codes for JDA Magazine tickets: j5pamkru2vcx4cr8 yrwgyv8mcck2wcbf Return to the Home screen, then click the present box icon (your Crate) in the middle of the page. Accept all of the draw tickets. Click the Menu button again and click Draw. On this Draw screen, you will see a scrolling banner listing detailed information about featured characters, a section showing examples of what is contained in the draw pool, a section for the Premium 10-Part Draw, and lastly, a section for (single) Premium Draw. In the Premium Draw (Single) section, use both of your Premium Draw Tickets. When you draw, the color of the crystal tells what you're about to roll: Blue: Rare (R), the lowest rarity you can get from Premium Draw. Can be either a weapon or a summon. Summons are pictured inside crystals. Standard rate is 82%. Blue (with rainbow tip): Rare character weapon. The weapon you get here will come with an R character. Amber: SR or better. It is still possible to get an SSR from this crystal if the shard that flies out is rainbow. Standard rate is 15%. Rainbow: SSR guaranteed. Standard rate is 3%, but doubles to 6% during Galas. For any shard, if the background turns to night, that means it's a character weapon. To roll the JDA Magazine and Max Level tickets, click the Ticket/Other tab on the top right of the Draw page. There will be a section for ticket rolls at the bottom.

IP Account Registration Limits.

If you receive an error after entering in your email address (will say リクエストパラメータに誤りがあります), your IP may have been temporarily blocked from creating new accounts. This will ALWAYS happen after creating 10 accounts from the exact same IP address within a single daily reset period. The block only seems to take place on the page where you enter your email address, so it's possible to enable a proxy, enter an email and click confirm, and then disable the proxy and continue the registration/rolling process.

What To Keep.

Obviously, keep any accounts that obtain characters you like. Very few characters in the game are outright bad, and it is simply a question of whether you are aiming for power over favoritism. Aiming to get an SSR of any kind is useful to start because of their high raw stats and rarity, and using the reroll opportunity to obtain one is the basic goal of rerolling in the first place.

For a brief character rating and overview, visit the Character Tier List page.

When rerolling in Granblue Fantasy, it is important to understand that certain characters and summons are exclusive to a certain time frame, and some characters and summons cannot be purchased with a Surprise Ticket or Beginner's Draw Set. Some of these exclusives are extremely powerful for a new account and may be worth keeping even if they are not a character you want.

Any seasonal character. Currently there are seasonal characters exclusive to summer, Halloween, Christmas and Valentine. Any Premium Gala and Flash Gala-exclusive character. Any Premium Non-ticketable summons, especially Bahamut, Lucifer, Shiva (Summon), Godsworn Alexiel, Europa (Summon), Grimnir (Summon), Uriel, Michael, Raphael, Gabriel, Metatron and Sariel due to their aura and call effects.

Other than that, it is recommended to keep all accounts with SSR characters and summons, as you can continue to build those accounts with more free rolls and Crystals distributed during events.

## Rerolling.

Because of the low rates for SSR draws from 2-4 rolls, it is common to end up with nothing but R draws. Don't lose heart as this process can be streamlined and rerolls can be done very quickly once you get used to it. Depending on what you got, you have two options:

Mobile device optimization for playing GBF?

I've recently started so I don't have much experience, but I've played this game over two different devices so far. First was the iPhone 6, which ran GBF (and all mobage really) fast, but it had some very annoying issues that would ultimately get me to try out a different phone for it. During cutscenes, voice lines would not play unless I tapped on the screen, even while the text was scrolling. In addition, I think there was a memory leak somewhere, as performance over time would deteriorate--leaving me with many audio hiccups and error messages that kicked me back to My Page, and finally hardlocking the app so that I would need to force kill the whole thing and rerun granblue from my home screen.

Running my Droid Turbo on this game now with Android 4.4 KitKat is nice and stable but slow slow, even despite the increased horsepower. I almost always get a lot of dropped visual frames because the phone's processor is trying to manage something else while trying to push all of that 1440p real estate.

Any thoughts or recommendations on machines optimized for mobage like this? (please don't suggest Chrome on desktop, I already do that)

EDIT Aug 16th: The correct answer for Android is taking Chrome for Android to gbf.game.mbga.jp, hands down the fastest solution and very similar to the iOS App native app experience.

The Apple A-series CPUs work so well with their own devices that the native app from the App Store is recommended, unless you have the above mentioned audio issues, in which Safari or even Chrome from iTunes is recommended.
